

This band is special because the seven band members are also the leaders of other traditional jazz bands. Jim Broadstreet, trumpet, is the leader of the All-Stars as well as the leader of his band, the Flying Eagles. Casey Jones, reeds, is a multi-instrumentalist and leader of the band, King Street Giants. Bill Badstubner, trombone, is the leader of the Gold Coast Jazz Band. Hugh O'Donnell, drums is very active with Mission Gold Jazz Band. Gerry Turner, bass; Virginia Tichenor, piano; and Phil Cartwright, banjo are major figures in traditional jazz and play with several different bands.

The second Sunday of each month, the Napa Valley Dixieland Jazz Society (also known as NVDJS) sponsors a different traditional jazz band. These bands revive the great 1920s music that was very popular then and is still fun and exciting to hear now. This site includes ample parking in the immediate area as well as lovely wooden floors with ample space for dancing. There are also a number of tables & chairs available, where you can enjoy listening to the special delightful music being played, unless you're choosing to dance to the same music. There is a bar available which includes a number of different beverages along with some snacks.
