Corner of Pearl Street & Franklin Street, 2 blocks Southwest of Main Street, downtown Napa. Parking lot at the American Legion Hall, free parking on street, plus free public parking structure across from this Hall, on Pearl Street

Cell Block Seven is a California jazz band favoring the West Coast traditional jazz sounds of Lu Watters, Turk Murphy and the Bay City Jazz Band of the '50's, with a classic jazz lineup of musicians led by two cornets. Their many festivals, tours and concert successes are a direct result of their very professional approach coupled with great sounds and an extensive repertoire.

As with most bands, the lineup has changed somewhat over the years, but most of the present team have been together for ten years or more. Cell Block 7 is a very versatile and entertaining band. By doubling their talents on the double bell euphoniums, Cell Block 7 is able to produce some very different sounds -- from fast, exciting trios to smooth and mellow blues -- all in great low brass harmony.
