The **Flying Eagles Jazz Band** was created years ago at the Sacramento Trad Jazz Adult Camp. The style captures a swinging four beat traditional jazz sound and lays down a steady groove for the dancers. The Flying Eagles band plays everything from slow blues and rags to spirituals and up-tempo classic jazz favorites and guarantees to keep the audience dancing.

Jim Broadstreet on trumpet is the leader. Playing music in the San Francisco bay area for decades, Jim came from a family of musicians and has a strong background in gospel music.

On trombone is **Bill Badstubner**, whose lifelong interest in traditional jazz began in the 1950's watching the Dixieland group on Lawrence Welk's weekly TV show.

Gerry Turner plays both tuba and stand-up bass with amazing proficiency.

Our piano player is **Rich Owens**. He helps drive the band with his fantastic energy. Rich also leads his own Thrown Together Jazz Band.

On drums is **Adam Roderick**. He's considered one of best drummers in the bay area.

Also holding the rhythm down on both guitar and banjo is **Jeff Green.** Jeff is also active in ragtime music.

On clarinet/reeds is our newest member, **Casey Jones**. Casey is a high school music director and also plays with the King Street Giants.

We continue to be very pleased with our current arrangements, where we hire a highly qualified Traditional Dixieland Jazz Band to perform at the American Legion Hall in downtown Napa (1240 Pearl Street) on the second Sunday of each month, from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. But we have found that we need additional contributions, beyond the annual membership dues and our minimal charge for admissions, to cover the costs of renting this facility each month and then to pay each of the excellent musicians as members of the particular band we've selected.

In this process of collecting more contributions to help cover the costs of our monthly operation, someone was willing, anonymously, to match any contribution we received for February & March, 2024, up to \$2,000. Doubling our contributions, through this "matching", helps tremendously. Through February 29th, we received \$1,300 extra from our "**Enthusiastic Supporters**", in contributions, which, when matched, will equal a gain of \$2,600 for NVDJS. Needless to say, those added contributions help us tremendously to maintain our monthly operations.

The contributions we receive in March, 2024 will also be matched by this anonymous donor, up to \$700 more.
